

(1) Compensation, at a rate determined by the Board, for each day on which the member is engaged in the duties of the member's office; and

(2) Reimbursement for expenses [under the Standard State Travel Regulations] AT A RATE DETERMINED BY THE BOARD.

(d) The Board may employ a staff in accordance with the [State] budget OF THE BOARD.

(A) THERE IS A STATE BOARD OF EXAMINERS FOR AUDIOLOGISTS AND SPEECH-LANGUAGE PATHOLOGISTS FUND.

[(a)] (B) (1) The Board shall set reasonable fees for the issuance and renewal of licenses and its other services.

(2) The fees charged shall be set so as to produce funds to approximate the cost of maintaining the Board.

(3) FUNDS TO COVER THE COMPENSATION AND EXPENSES OF THE BOARD MEMBERS SHALL BE GENERATED BY FEES SET UNDER THIS SECTION.

[(b)] (C) ~~{(1)}~~ In accordance with the [State] budget OF THE BOARD, the Board may pay expenses incurred in carrying out the provisions of this title.

~~{(2)}~~ The expenses of the Board and the State Board of Examiners for Audiologists shall be consolidated as a single item in the ~~State~~ budget OF THE BOARD.

[(c)] (D) (1) The Board shall pay all funds collected under this title [into the General Fund of this] TO THE COMPTROLLER OF THE State.

(2) THE COMPTROLLER SHALL DISTRIBUTE THE FEES TO THE STATE BOARD OF EXAMINERS FOR AUDIOLOGISTS AND SPEECH-LANGUAGE PATHOLOGISTS FUND.

(E) (1) THE FUND SHALL BE USED TO COVER THE ACTUAL DOCUMENTED DIRECT AND INDIRECT COSTS OF FULFILLING THE STATUTORY AND REGULATORY DUTIES OF THE BOARD AS PROVIDED BY THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ARTICLE.

~~{(2)}~~ (2) THE FUND IS A CONTINUING NONLAPSING FUND, NOT SUBJECT TO § 7-302 OF THE STATE FINANCE AND PROCUREMENT ARTICLE.

~~{(2)}~~ (3) ANY UNSPENT PORTIONS OF THE FUND MAY NOT BE TRANSFERRED OR REVERT TO THE GENERAL FUND OF THE STATE, BUT SHALL REMAIN IN THE FUND TO BE USED FOR THE PURPOSES SPECIFIED IN THIS ARTICLE.
