

(4) NO OTHER STATE MONEY MAY BE USED TO SUPPORT THE FUND.

(F) (1) A DESIGNEE OF THE BOARD SHALL ADMINISTER THE FUND.

(2) MONEYS IN THE FUND MAY BE EXPENDED ONLY FOR ANY LAWFUL PURPOSE AUTHORIZED UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ARTICLE.

(G) THE LEGISLATIVE AUDITOR SHALL AUDIT THE ACCOUNTS AND TRANSACTIONS OF THE FUND AS PROVIDED IN § 2-1215 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Health Occupations

2-206.

(A) THERE IS A STATE BOARD OF EXAMINERS FOR AUDIOLOGISTS, HEARING AID DEALERS, AND SPEECH-LANGUAGE PATHOLOGISTS FUND.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Section 2 of this Act shall take effect October 1, 1993, contingent on the taking effect of Chapter ____ (S.B. 271) or Chapter ____ (H.B. 548) of the Acts of the General Assembly of 1992 and if Chapter ____ or Chapter ____ take effect, § 2-206(a) of the Health Occupations Article as added by Section 1 of this Act shall become null and void without the necessity of further action by the General Assembly.

AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the changes to Sections 3-204, 3-206, 4-204, 4-207, 5-204, 5-206, 6-204, 6-206, 11-204, 11-207, 12-204, 12-206, 12-303, 13-205, 13-207, 16-204, 16-206, 17-204, 17-206, 19-204, and 19-206 of the Health Occupations Article made by Section 1 of this Act and Section 3 of this Act shall take effect on July 1, 1992, and the changes to Sections 2-204, 2-206, 7-204, 7-206, 10-204, 10-206, 18-204, 18-207, 20-204, and 20-206 of the Health Occupations Article made by Section 1 of this Act shall take effect on October 1, 1993.

AN ACT concerning

State Board of Physician Quality Assurance - Licensure of Eminent Physicians

FOR the purpose of authorizing the State Board of Physician Quality Assurance to license certain physicians without special examination under certain circumstances;
