SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 24 - Political Subdivisions - Miscellaneous Provisions

10-101.

- (a) In this section, "political subdivision":
 - (1) Means any political subdivision of the State; and
 - (2) Includes:
 - (i) A county;
 - (ii) A municipal corporation;
 - (iii) A bicounty agency;
 - (iv) A county board of education;
 - (v) A public corporation; and
 - (vi) A special taxing district.
- (b) Each political subdivision shall afford its employees who return from military service the same reemployment rights provided for State employees under Article 64A, § 18B of the Code.
