Preamble

WHEREAS, America is a nation of immigrants where people are often identified by their ethnic or geographic origin; and

WHEREAS, Americans of African ancestry have been referred to as "Negro", "colored", "Afro-American", and "Black"; and

WHEREAS, The term "African American" is more reflective of an increasing number of black Americans' awareness and acceptance of their African heritage; and

WHEREAS, The General Assembly intends that the term "African American" include all peoples previously identified by the terms "Black", "Negro", "colored", "Afro-American", or similar terms; now, therefore,

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 83B - Department of Housing and Community Development
