(6) Publish an annual report and any other material it deems necessary. 5-304.

The records, materials, personal property, files, moneys, credits and other assets and liabilities and obligations of the Maryland Commission on Negro History and Culture are hereby transferred to the Maryland Commission on [Afro-American] AFRICAN AMERICAN History and Culture.

5-306.

(a) The Commissioners, subject to the approval of the Secretary, shall appoint from without their number a director of the Commission on [Afro-American] AFRICAN AMERICAN History and Culture.

7-106.

(b) (1) Each county board shall adopt procedures for the selection and purchase for use in each public school library or media center of a collection of books and auditory and visual materials concerning [black] AFRICAN AMERICAN history.

10-203.

- (c) Funding proposals for public senior higher education institutions shall include:
- (1) Base funding in accordance with the role and mission of the institution, as approved by the Maryland Higher Education Commission;
 - (2) Special initiative funding:
- (i) For academic programs at historically [black] AFRICAN AMERICAN colleges and universities; and
 - (ii) For the reward of academic innovation and enhancement; and
- (3) Capital funding to support construction, operation, and maintenance of a physical plant that is consistent with each institution's mission.

- (e) (1) The Commission is responsible for:
- (i) Developing a program of desegregation and equal educational opportunity, including developing an enhancement plan, for historically [black] AFRICAN AMERICAN colleges and universities;
- (ii) Monitoring the progress made under, and assuring compliance with, the goals, measures, and commitments contained in the desegregation and equal education opportunity plan;
