

- (i) organized to engage in commercial transactions; and
- (ii) at least 51% owned and controlled by 1 or more individuals who are members of a group that is disadvantaged socially or economically, including:
 - 1. AFRICAN AMERICANS;
 - [1.] 2. American Indians;
 - [2.] 3. Asians;
 - [3. Blacks;]
 - 4. Hispanics;
 - 5. women; or
 - 6. physically or mentally disabled individuals.

Article – State Government

IN THE PREPARATION OF A REGULATION, A UNIT SHALL USE THE TERM "AFRICAN AMERICAN" INSTEAD OF "BLACK", "NEGRO", "AFRO-AMERICAN", OR SIMILAR TERMS.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, in State publications, the term "African American" is preferred instead of "black", "Negro", "Afro-American", or similar terms.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1992.

CHAPTER 291

(House Bill 167)

AN ACT concerning

Queen Anne's County – Attorney Appearance Fees

FOR the purpose of requiring that attorney appearance fees *in Queen Anne's County* be distributed to the Queen Anne's County Bar Association; providing that the fees be retained in a separate Law Library Fund; authorizing the Bar Association, with approval of the County Circuit Administrative Judge, to make distributions from the Law Library Fund for the purchase and maintenance of legal publications and equipment for the County Law Library; and generally relating to the distribution of attorney appearance fees in Queen Anne's County.
