

(v) In all other criminal cases — \$10.

(e) (1) In Queen Anne's County, the Clerk of the Circuit Court shall DISTRIBUTE ALL APPEARANCE FEES COLLECTED UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION TO THE QUEEN ANNE'S COUNTY BAR ASSOCIATION.

(2) THE QUEEN ANNE'S COUNTY BAR ASSOCIATION SHALL RETAIN THE FEES IN A SEPARATE LAW LIBRARY FUND.

(3) THE QUEEN ANNE'S COUNTY BAR ASSOCIATION, WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE COUNTY ~~CIRCUIT~~ ADMINISTRATIVE JUDGE, MAY MAKE DISTRIBUTIONS FROM THE LAW LIBRARY FUND FOR THE PURCHASE AND MAINTENANCE OF LEGAL PUBLICATIONS AND EQUIPMENT FOR THE COUNTY LAW LIBRARY.

(4) ALL PROPERTY ACQUIRED UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL BE USED AND MAINTAINED AS PART OF THE COUNTY LAW LIBRARY. [retain all appearance fees collected under subsection (a) of this section for purchasing and maintaining legal publications recommended for purchase by the library committee of the Queen Anne's County Bar Association, and approved by the County Administrative Judge of the second judicial circuit for the general purposes of the law library of the county.]

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1992.

CHAPTER 292

(House Bill 171)

AN ACT concerning

Home Improvement Guaranty Fund – Reimbursement – Liens

FOR the purpose of creating a lien on any real property of a person who is liable for reimbursing and who fails to reimburse the Home Improvement Guaranty Fund; establishing the time when the lien attaches to certain property; authorizing the clerk of the court to collect a certain fee; requiring that the lien be recorded by the State Central Collection Unit and indexed in a certain place; ~~providing that a guarantor or indemnitor of a licensee is jointly and severally liable for a claim against the licensee under certain circumstances;~~ and generally relating to the Home Improvement Guaranty Fund.
