6-2A-02.

There is a Child Care Facilities Direct Loan Fund administered by the Department. 6-2A-03.

- (a) The Direct Loan Fund shall be used as a nonlapsing revolving fund to make direct loans for the expansion or development of child care facilities in this State.
- (b) The Secretary of the Department may delegate the authority to approve direct loans to any board which exists or may be created within the Department.

 6-2A-08.

The Department may make a loan to an applicant only if:

- (1) The applicant meets the qualifications required by this subtitle; and
- (2) The loan is to be used for expansion or financing of a child care facility. 6-2A-09.
- (a) To apply for financial assistance, an applicant shall submit to the Department an application on the form that the Department requires.
 - (b) The application shall include:
 - (1) A detailed description of the proposed or existing child care facility;
 - (2) An itemization of known and estimated costs;
- (3) The total amount of investment required to expand or develop the child care facility;
- (4) The funds available to the applicant without financial assistance from the Department;
 - (5) The amount of financial assistance sought from the Department;
- (6) Evidence of the inability of the applicant to obtain the financing necessary for the facility on reasonable terms through normal lending channels, including documentation that the applicant for a direct loan has applied for and been denied a loan by 2 financial institutions;
- (7) Information that relates to the financial status of the applicant, including, if applicable:
 - (i) A current balance sheet;
 - (ii) A profit and loss statement; and
 - (iii) Credit references;
