(b) In addition to the provisions of this subtitle, every society has the powers under and is subject to the provisions of Title 6, Subtitle 4 of the Corporations and Associations Article AND TITLE 13, SUBTITLE 5 OF THE ESTATES AND TRUSTS ARTICLE.

(House Bill 278)

AN ACT concerning

Partnership for Workforce Quality – Sunset Repeal

FOR the purpose of ~~repealing the provision of law that would terminate extending until June 30, 1997~~ the Partnership for Workforce Quality Program; imposing limitations on Maryland employers who may receive assistance under the Program and establishing priorities for eligible employers; limiting the amount of money available to a single employer; repealing certain provisions relating to use of a voucher system in providing training assistance for employees; and generally relating to the Partnership for Workforce Quality Program.
