

Article 48A - Insurance Code

41.

The Commissioner shall collect in advance, and the persons so served shall pay the following fees to the Commissioner:

(12) For valuing life insurance policies, other than group OR CREDIT:

(i) For the first \$14,000,000 of insurance or any fractional part thereof \$ 350.00

(ii) For each additional \$1,000,000 of insurance or fractional part thereof \$ 25.00

(13) For valuing group life insurance policies OTHER THAN CREDIT, per million of insurance or any fractional part thereof \$ 3.00

(13A) FOR VALUING INDIVIDUAL AND GROUP CREDIT LIFE INSURANCE POLICIES, PER MILLION OF INSURANCE OR ANY FRACTIONAL PART THEREOF \$ 12.00

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1992.

CHAPTER 301

(House Bill 286)

AN ACT concerning

Juvenile Causes - Restitution - Counseling Expenses

FOR the purpose of permitting a court to enter a judgment of restitution against certain persons for certain delinquent acts by a child causing the victim of the delinquent act to incur reasonable counseling expenses from a licensed health care provider; specifying that the delinquent acts for which a court may enter a judgment of restitution for reasonable counseling expenses are those involving personal injury, certain types of abuse, or certain other acts of a sexual nature; and generally relating to restitution in juvenile cases.
