SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

5-501.

(f) "Foster care" means continuous 24-hour care and supportive services provided for a minor child, in a family home or group facility, while the child needs substitute care.

5-561.

- (a) Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, an employee and employer in a facility identified in subsection (b) of this section and persons identified in subsection (c) of this section shall apply for a federal and State criminal background investigation at any designated law enforcement office in this State.
- (b) The following facilities shall require employees and employers to obtain a criminal background investigation under this Part VI of this subtitle:
- (1) a child care center required to be licensed under Part VII of this subtitle;
- (2) a family day care home required to be registered under Part V of this subtitle:
- (3) a child care home required to be licensed under this subtitle or under Article 83C of the Code;
