

CHAPTER 305

(House Bill 314)

AN ACT concerning

Well Drilling - Permit Fee

FOR the purpose of increasing the amount of the maximum fee that a county board of health may charge for a permit to drill a well; providing a certain term for the permit; and altering the purposes for which the money from the fee may be used by the board of health.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Environment

9-1307.

(c) A county board of health may establish a permit fee to defray county expenses in inspecting AND TESTING wells. The fee may be charged before a permit required under § 9-1306 of this subtitle is issued. The fee may not exceed [\$40] \$80 per well. A PERMIT SHALL BE VALID FOR A PERIOD OF 12 MONTHS FROM THE DATE OF ISSUANCE BY THE COUNTY BOARD OF HEALTH.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1992.
