

[(ii)] 2. The percentage of income, gains, and losses applicable to [each] THE system OR SYSTEMS; and

[(iii)] 3. The total contributions and disbursements applicable to [each] THE system OR SYSTEMS.

(II) THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES SHALL MAINTAIN THE RECORDS REQUIRED UNDER SUBPARAGRAPH (I) OF THIS PARAGRAPH FOR EACH OF THE FOLLOWING SYSTEMS OR GROUPS OF SYSTEMS:

1. THE TEACHERS' RETIREMENT SYSTEM OF THE STATE OF MARYLAND AND THE PENSION SYSTEM FOR TEACHERS OF THE STATE OF MARYLAND;

2. THE STATE POLICE RETIREMENT SYSTEM OF THE STATE OF MARYLAND;

3. A. THE EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT SYSTEM OF THE STATE OF MARYLAND;

B. THE PENSION SYSTEM FOR EMPLOYEES OF THE STATE OF MARYLAND;

C. THE CORRECTIONAL OFFICERS' RETIREMENT SYSTEM OF THE STATE OF MARYLAND; AND

D. THE LEGISLATIVE RETIREMENT PLAN OF THE STATE OF MARYLAND;

4. THE NATURAL RESOURCES LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS' PENSION SYSTEM;

5. THE JUDGES' RETIREMENT SYSTEM OF THE STATE OF MARYLAND; AND

6. THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATIONS LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS' AND FIRE FIGHTERS' PENSION SYSTEM.
