- (3) (4) NO PART OF THE LIGHTHOUSE PRESERVATION SPECIAL FUND MAY REVERT OR BE CREDITED TO THE GENERAL FUND OR ANY OTHER SPECIAL FUND OF THE STATE.
  - (D) THE MARYLAND HISTORICAL TRUST MAY:
- (1) APPLY FOR AND ACCEPT ANY FUND, OR GRANT, OR LOAN FROM ANY FEDERAL, STATE, LOCAL, OR PRIVATE SOURCE FOR THE CREDIT OF TO THE FUND THAT MIGHT ASSIST WITH THE PRESERVATION OF LIGHTHOUSES IN THE STATE THAT ARE PUBLICLY OWNED OR NOT FOR PROFIT; AND
- (2) CONTRACT FOR AND SELL BY ANY METHOD ANY ITEM THAT RELATES TO A LIGHTHOUSE PRESERVATION, THE PROCEEDS FROM WHICH SHALL BE GIVEN TO THE STATE COMPTROLLER FOR THE CREDIT OF CREDITED TO THE FUND.
- (E) (1) AFTER MEETING ITS DEBT SERVICE REQUIREMENTS, AND ON RECOMMENDATION OF THE COMMISSION, THE TRUST MAY USE ANY MONEY IN THE FUND FOR THE PRESERVATION OF ANY LIGHTHOUSE IN THE STATE THAT IS PUBLICLY OWNED OR NOT FOR PROFIT.
- (2) THE TRUST MAY NOT USE ANY MONEY IN THE FUND FOR ANY OTHER PURPOSE OF THE TRUST.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an emergency measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety, has been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take effect from the date it is enacted.

## **CHAPTER 310**

(House Bill 359)

AN ACT concerning

Retirement and Pension Systems - Retired Members - Reemployment as County Administrator

FOR the purpose of exempting certain members of the Employees' Retirement System of the State of Maryland, the Teachers' Retirement System of the State of Maryland, the Pension System for Employees of the State of Maryland, or the Pension System for Teachers of the State of Maryland who are reemployed in an appointed position as county administrator for certain counties from certain restrictions on retirement benefits upon reemployment under certain circumstances; providing for the construction of this Act; requiring the reimbursement of certain employer courts for
