(2) A RECORD OF A SALE OR OTHER TRANSACTION THAT INVOLVES A WEAPON OR POISON THAT CAN BE USED IN COMMITTING A CRIME.

## (B) AUTHORIZED.

UNLESS A SPECIFIC PERIOD IS SET BY LAW FOR THE PRESERVATION OF A BUSINESS RECORD THAT IS REQUIRED BY THE LAWS OF THIS STATE TO BE KEPT, THE BUSINESS RECORD MAY BE DESTROYED 3 YEARS AFTER IT IS MADE.

## 1-305. REPRODUCTIONS.

(A) "REPRODUCTION" DEFINED.

IN THIS SECTION, "REPRODUCTION" MEANS A REPRODUCTION OR DURABLE MEDIUM FOR MAKING A REPRODUCTION OBTAINED BY A PHOTOGRAPHIC, PHOTOSTATIC, MICROFILM, MICROCARD, MINIATURE PHOTOGRAPHIC, OR OTHER PROCESS THAT ACCURATELY REPRODUCES OR FORMS A DURABLE MEDIUM FOR SO REPRODUCING THE ORIGINAL.

(B) PRESERVATION OF REPRODUCTIONS.

IF, IN THE REGULAR COURSE OF BUSINESS, A PERSON MAKES A REPRODUCTION OF AN ORIGINAL BUSINESS RECORD, THE PRESERVATION OF THE REPRODUCTION COMPLIES WITH A REQUIREMENT OF A LAW OF THE STATE THAT THE BUSINESS RECORD BE KEPT.
