

Article 2B – Alcoholic Beverages

5.

(g) (1) A Class 6 pub-brewery license shall be issued:

(i) By the State Comptroller; and

(ii) Only to a holder of a Class B beer, wine and liquor (on-sale) license that is issued for use on the premises of a restaurant located in Anne Arundel County, the City of Annapolis, Baltimore City, FREDERICK COUNTY, or Harford County.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1992.

CHAPTER 315

(House Bill 441)

AN ACT concerning

Natural Resources – Chesapeake Bay Critical Area Commission – Membership of Secretary of Transportation

FOR the purpose of adding the Maryland Secretary of Transportation to the Chesapeake Bay Critical Area Commission as an ex officio voting member of the Commission; and generally relating to the Chesapeake Bay Critical Area Commission.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – Natural Resources

8-1804.

(a) The Commission consists of [26] 27 voting members who are appointed by the Governor, as follows:

(1) A full-time chairman, appointed with the advice and consent of the Senate, who shall serve at the pleasure of the Governor;
