- (b) (1) Any person or school operating an athletic facility shall obtain and affix at least 1 warning notice in each locker room maintained in the facility [and at least 1 warning notice at each entrance to the athletic facility].
- (2) The lettering in each warning notice shall be at least 1 inch in height, and shall be conspicuously positioned for the maximum possible visibility.
 - (3) The text of the warning notice shall be as follows:

WARNING

The nonprescription use, possession, or distribution of anabolic steroids or human growth hormone is illegal in the State of Maryland. Upon conviction, violators are subject to a fine or imprisonment or both.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1992.

CHAPTER 324

(House Bill 522)

AN ACT concerning

Health Insurance - Interdepartmental Committee on Mandated Health Insurance Benefits

FOR the purpose of clarifying provisions relating to the composition of the Interdepartmental Committee on Mandated Health Insurance Benefits; clarifying the composition of an expert panel appointed by the Interdepartmental Committee; requiring the Executive Director of the Committee to ensure compliance with the applicable provisions of the Insurance Code; clarifying the requirements for the contents of a report by an expert panel; allowing the Committee to identify areas in which a report is not in compliance with the law and to return the report to the panel for reconsideration of those areas; and generally relating to the Interdepartmental Committee on Mandated Health Insurance Benefits.
