

3. The cost increases on various components of the State's economy;

4. The quality of the health care system in the State; and

5. The utilization of the mandated health insurance benefit, nondiscrimination provision, or beneficiary or length of coverage provisions and related services;

(iii) The effect of a mandated health insurance benefit, nondiscrimination provision, and beneficiary or length of coverage provisions on a benefit package provided by an employer; and

(iv) Any other finding concerning a mandated health insurance benefit, nondiscrimination provision, and beneficiary or length of coverage provisions] ANY MATTER REFERRED TO IN PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION.

(5) (I) The panel shall transmit its report to the Committee by October 31.

(II) THE COMMITTEE MAY:

1. IDENTIFY ANY AREAS IN WHICH THE REPORT IS NOT IN COMPLIANCE WITH THIS SECTION; AND

2. RETURN THE REPORT TO THE PANEL FOR RECONSIDERATION OF THOSE AREAS.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1992.

CHAPTER 325

(House Bill 537)

AN ACT concerning

State Board of Pharmacy

FOR the purpose of altering the process for nominating members to the State Board of Pharmacy; eliminating certain county and Baltimore City residency requirements for members of the Board; extending the termination date for the Board; making certain technical corrections; and generally relating to the State Board of Pharmacy.
