services from engaging in certain unfair or deceptive trade practices; establishing certain rehabilitation committees; prohibiting certain persons from making certain representations; making a certain exception; providing for the termination of this Act subject to the evaluation and reestablishment provisions of the Maryland Program Evaluation Act; providing that nothing in this Act affects the terms of certain members of certain boards, except under certain circumstances; providing that certain members of certain boards shall become members of a certain board on a certain date; providing that certain persons licensed by certain boards shall be considered to remain licensed for the duration of a certain term and that certain licenses may be renewed in accordance with certain provisions of law; providing for the transfer of certain functions, powers, duties, assets, and liabilities of certain boards to a certain board; and generally relating to audiologists fitting and selling hearing aids the licensing and regulation of audiologists, hearing aid dealers, and speech-language pathologists by the State Board of Examiners for Audiologists, Hearing Aid Dealers, and Speech-Language Pathologists.
