

(1) SOLELY FOR THE PURPOSES OF CHOOSING, ADAPTING, OR SELLING HEARING AIDS OR FOR THE USE OF A MEMBER OF A HEALTH OCCUPATION THAT HAS A PROFESSIONAL CONCERN ABOUT HUMAN HEARING, TO MEASURE HUMAN HEARING BY ANY MEANS, INCLUDING THE PREPARATION OF AN AUDIOGRAM BY MEANS OF AN AUDIOMETER AND EVALUATION OF THE AUDIOGRAM;

(2) TO MAKE AN IMPRESSION OF A HUMAN EAR FOR THE PURPOSE OF BUILDING AN EAR MOLD; OR

(3) TO PROVIDE ADVICE ABOUT THE CHOICE OR USE OF A HEARING AID BY A HEARING IMPAIRED INDIVIDUAL.

(E) "HEARING AID" MEANS:

(1) ANY INSTRUMENT OR DEVICE THAT IS DESIGNED FOR OR REPRESENTED AS BEING CAPABLE OF IMPROVING OR CORRECTING IMPAIRED HUMAN HEARING; OR

(2) ANY PART OR ACCESSORY OF THE INSTRUMENT OR DEVICE.

(F) "HEARING AID DEALER" MEANS AN INDIVIDUAL WHO PROVIDES HEARING AID SERVICES.

~~[(d)]~~ (G) (1) "License" means, unless the context requires otherwise, a license issued by the Board to practice audiology, TO PROVIDE HEARING AID SERVICES, OR TO PRACTICE SPEECH-LANGUAGE PATHOLOGY.

(2) "LICENSE" INCLUDES, UNLESS THE CONTEXT REQUIRES OTHERWISE, A LIMITED LICENSE.

~~[(e)]~~ (H) "Licensed audiologist" means, unless the context requires otherwise, an audiologist who is licensed by the Board to practice audiology.

(I) "LICENSED HEARING AID DEALER" MEANS, UNLESS THE CONTEXT REQUIRES OTHERWISE, A HEARING AID DEALER WHO IS LICENSED BY THE BOARD TO PROVIDE HEARING AID SERVICES.

(J) "LICENSED SPEECH-LANGUAGE PATHOLOGIST" MEANS, UNLESS THE CONTEXT REQUIRES OTHERWISE, A SPEECH-LANGUAGE PATHOLOGIST WHO IS LICENSED BY THE BOARD TO PRACTICE SPEECH-LANGUAGE PATHOLOGY.

~~[(f)]~~ (K) "Limited license" TO PRACTICE AUDIOLOGY means a license issued by the Board as limited by § 2-310 of this title to practice audiology.

(L) "LIMITED LICENSE TO PRACTICE SPEECH-LANGUAGE PATHOLOGY" MEANS A LICENSE ISSUED BY THE BOARD AS LIMITED BY § 2-310.2 OF THIS TITLE TO PRACTICE SPEECH-LANGUAGE PATHOLOGY.
