

(D) AUTHORIZATION LIMITED.

A LICENSE ISSUED UNDER THIS SUBTITLE DOES NOT AUTHORIZE THE LICENSEE TO ENGAGE IN A BUSINESS OR PROVIDE A SERVICE THAT MAY BE ENGAGED IN OR PROVIDED ONLY BY A PERSON LICENSED UNDER OTHER STATE OR LOCAL LAW.

REVISOR'S NOTE: Subsection (a) of this section is a standard provision added for clarity. It is supported by the phrase "including the fee for one salesman's license" in former Art. 56, § 254(b)(1), which is deleted as unnecessary and misleading. In practice, a contractor receives a single license and that license authorizes the licensee both to perform home improvement as a contractor or subcontractor and to sell a home improvement.

Subsections (b) and (c) of this section are standard provisions added for clarity.

Subsection (d) of this section is new language derived without substantive change from the first clause of former Art. 56, § 247(b).

8-308. TERM AND RENEWAL OF LICENSE.

(A) AUTHORITY TO STAGGER TERMS.

THE SECRETARY MAY STAGGER THE TERMS OF LICENSES.

(B) TERM OF LICENSE.

UNLESS A LICENSE IS RENEWED FOR A 2-YEAR TERM AS PROVIDED IN THIS SECTION, THE LICENSE EXPIRES:

(1) IF THE SECRETARY STAGGERS THE TERMS OF LICENSES, ON THE DATE THAT THE SECRETARY SETS; OR

(2) IF THE SECRETARY DOES NOT STAGGER THE TERMS OF LICENSES, ON THE FIRST JUNE 30 THAT COMES AFTER THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THE LICENSE IN AN ODD-NUMBERED YEAR.

(C) RENEWAL NOTICE.

AT LEAST 1 MONTH BEFORE A LICENSE EXPIRES, THE COMMISSION SHALL MAIL TO THE LICENSEE, AT THE LAST KNOWN ADDRESS OF THE LICENSEE:
