

(1) A RENEWAL APPLICATION FORM; AND

(2) A NOTICE THAT STATES:

(I) THE DATE ON WHICH THE CURRENT LICENSE EXPIRES;

(II) THE DATE BY WHICH THE COMMISSION MUST RECEIVE THE RENEWAL APPLICATION FOR THE RENEWAL TO BE ISSUED AND MAILED BEFORE THE LICENSE EXPIRES; AND

(III) THE AMOUNT OF THE RENEWAL FEE.

(D) APPLICATIONS FOR RENEWAL.

(1) BEFORE A LICENSE EXPIRES, THE LICENSEE PERIODICALLY MAY RENEW IT FOR AN ADDITIONAL 2-YEAR TERM, IF THE LICENSEE:

(I) OTHERWISE IS ENTITLED TO BE LICENSED;

(II) SUBMITS TO THE COMMISSION A RENEWAL APPLICATION ON THE FORM THAT THE COMMISSION PROVIDES; AND

(III) PAYS TO THE COMMISSION A RENEWAL FEE.

(2) THE RENEWAL FEE:

(I) FOR A CONTRACTOR LICENSE IS \$225 FOR EACH PLACE OF BUSINESS OF THE CONTRACTOR;

(II) FOR A SUBCONTRACTOR LICENSE IS \$125; OR

(III) FOR A SALESPERSON LICENSE IS \$75.

(3) NOTWITHSTANDING PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, A LICENSEE THAT IS INCORPORATED OR HAS ITS PRINCIPAL OFFICE IN ANOTHER STATE SHALL PAY TO THE COMMISSION THE FEE IMPOSED IN THAT STATE ON A SIMILAR NONRESIDENT BUSINESS IF THAT FEE IS HIGHER THAN THE RENEWAL FEE UNDER PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION.

(E) ISSUANCE OF RENEWAL.

THE COMMISSION SHALL RENEW THE LICENSE OF EACH LICENSEE WHO MEETS THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SECTION.

REVISOR'S NOTE: Subsections (a), (b), (c)(1), and (d)(1)(iii) and (3) of this section are new language derived without substantive change from former Art. 56, § 257(h), (k), and, as it related to providing renewal forms, (f), and, as they related to biennial renewal fees, § 254(b)(1), (2), and (3).

Subsection (c)(2) of this section is standard language added, and subsection (c)(1) is revised in standard language, to conform to the practice of the Commission and to similar provisions governing other State-regulated occupations. See, e.g., BOP §§ 4-311 and 12-308.
