- (2) PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO ANY RECORD OR DOCUMENT THAT IS CONSIDERED BY THE SPEECH-LANGUAGE PATHOLOGIST REHABILITATION COMMITTEE AND THAT OTHERWISE WOULD BE SUBJECT TO DISCOVERY OR INTRODUCTION INTO EVIDENCE IN A CIVIL ACTION.
- (3) FOR PURPOSES OF THIS SUBSECTION, CIVIL ACTION DOES NOT INCLUDE A PROCEEDING BEFORE THE BOARD OR JUDICIAL REVIEW OF A PROCEEDING BEFORE THE BOARD.
- (F) A PERSON WHO ACTS IN GOOD FAITH AND WITHIN THE SCOPE OF JURISDICTION OF A SPEECH-LANGUAGE PATHOLOGIST REHABILITATION COMMITTEE IS NOT CIVILITY LIABLE FOR ANY ACTION AS A MEMBER OF THE SPEECH-LANGUAGE PATHOLOGIST REHABILITATION COMMITTEE OR FOR GIVING INFORMATION TO, PARTICIPATING IN, OR CONTRIBUTING TO THE FUNCTION OF THE SPEECH-LANGUAGE PATHOLOGIST REHABILITATION COMMITTEE.

- (A) IN THIS SECTION, "HEARING AID DEALER REHABILITATION COMMITTEE" MEANS A COMMITTEE THAT:
 - (1) IS DEFINED IN SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION; AND
- (D) OF THIS SECTION.
- (B) FOR PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION, A HEARING AID DEALER REHABILITATION COMMITTEE IS A COMMITTEE OF THE BOARD OR A COMMITTEE OF THE MARYLAND MEMBERS OF THE HEARING AID SPECIALIST ASSOCIATION OF MARYLAND, DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, AND DELAWARE THAT:
 - (1) IS RECOGNIZED BY THE BOARD; AND
 - (2) INCLUDES BUT IS NOT LIMITED TO HEARING AID DEALERS.
- (C) A REHABILITATION COMMITTEE OF THE BOARD OR RECOGNIZED BY THE BOARD MAY FUNCTION:
 - (1) SOLELY FOR THE BOARD; OR
- (2) JOINTLY WITH A REHABILITATION COMMITTEE REPRESENTING ANOTHER BOARD OR BOARDS.
- (D) FOR PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION, A HEARING AID DEALER REHABILITATION COMMITTEE EVALUATES AND PROVIDES ASSISTANCE TO ANY HEARING AID DEALER, AND ANY OTHER INDIVIDUAL
