Article 78 - Public Service Commission Law

- (h) (1) "Gas company" means [and includes (1) any]:
- (I) ANY public service company authorized to erect, lay down or maintain pipes, conduits, duets or other fixtures in, over, or under streets for furnishing or distributing gas; [and (2) any]
 - (II) ANY public service company [which (A)] THAT:
 - 1. [owns] OWNS any gas plant[, and (B)]; AND
- 2. [transmits] TRANSMITS, sells, supplies, or distributes artificial or natural gas, or manufactures gas for distribution or sale; [and (3) every] OR
- (III) A municipal corporation in the business of supplying gas for other than municipal purposes.
- (2) "GAS COMPANY" DOES NOT INCLUDE A COMPANY THAT SELLS, SUPPLIES, OR DISTRIBUTES NATURAL GAS FOR USE AS A FUEL FOR A MOTOR VEHICLE.

NATURAL GAS VEHICLES

64E.

- (A) IN THIS SECTION, "NATURAL GAS VEHICLE" MEANS ANY VEHICLE OPERATED ON ANY PUBLIC ROAD AND POWERED BY NATURAL GAS.
- (B) THE SALE BY ANY PERSON OF NATURAL GAS THAT IS RECEIVED FROM A PUBLIC SERVICE COMPANY FOR USE AS A MOTOR FUEL IN A NATURAL GAS VEHICLE IS NOT SUBJECT TO REGULATION BY THE COMMISSION.
- (C) ANY PERSON SELLING NATURAL GAS RECEIVED FROM A PUBLIC SERVICE COMPANY FOR USE AS A MOTOR FUEL IN A NATURAL GAS VEHICLE IS NOT CONSIDERED A PUBLIC SERVICE COMPANY FOR PURPOSES OF THIS ARTICLE.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1992.
