

(1) THAT CONTRACTOR THE NAME OF EACH OTHER CONTRACTOR FOR WHOM THE INDIVIDUAL CURRENTLY IS A SALESPERSON; AND

(2) EACH CONTRACTOR FOR WHOM THE INDIVIDUAL CURRENTLY IS A SALESPERSON THE NAME OF THE CONTRACTOR FOR WHOM THE INDIVIDUAL PLANS TO BECOME A SALESPERSON.

(C) CESSATION OF RELATIONSHIP.

WHEN AN INDIVIDUAL CEASES TO BE A SALESPERSON FOR A CONTRACTOR, THE CONTRACTOR SHALL GIVE THE COMMISSION WRITTEN NOTICE OF THE CESSATION.

8-311. DENIALS, REPRIMANDS, SUSPENSIONS, AND REVOCATIONS - GROUNDS; PENALTY.

(A) IN GENERAL.

SUBJECT TO THE HEARING PROVISIONS OF § 8-312 OF THIS SUBTITLE, THE COMMISSION MAY DENY A LICENSE TO AN APPLICANT, REPRIMAND A LICENSEE, OR SUSPEND OR REVOKE A LICENSE IF THE APPLICANT OR LICENSEE OR THE MANAGEMENT PERSONNEL OF THE APPLICANT OR LICENSEE:

(1) FRAUDULENTLY OR DECEPTIVELY OBTAINS OR ATTEMPTS TO OBTAIN A LICENSE FOR THE APPLICANT OR LICENSEE OR FOR ANOTHER PERSON;

(2) FRAUDULENTLY OR DECEPTIVELY USES A LICENSE;

(3) FAILS TO GIVE THE COMMISSION INFORMATION REQUIRED BY THIS SUBTITLE ABOUT AN APPLICATION FOR A LICENSE;

(4) FAILS TO PASS AN EXAMINATION REQUIRED BY THIS SUBTITLE;

(5) IS CONVICTED OF A FELONY;

(6) OFTEN FAILS TO PERFORM HOME IMPROVEMENT CONTRACTS;

(7) FALSIFIES AN ACCOUNT;

(8) ENGAGES IN FRAUD;
