- (a) The Board shall set reasonable fees for:
 - (1) The issuance and renewal of certificates; and
- (2) The other services rendered by the Board in connection with physician assistants.
- (b) The Board shall pay all funds collected under this title [into the General Fund of the State] TO THE COMPTROLLER OF THE STATE.
 - (C) THE COMPTROLLER SHALL DISTRIBUTE:
- (1) 20 PERCENT OF THE FEES RECEIVED FROM THE BOARD TO THE GENERAL FUND OF THE STATE; AND
- (2) THE BALANCE OF THE FEES TO THE STATE BOARD OF PHYSICIAN QUALITY ASSURANCE FUND.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1992.
