

CHAPTER 352

(House Bill 706)

AN ACT concerning

Estates and Trusts – Definition of “Net Estate”

FOR the purpose of providing that for purposes of calculating a spouse’s elective share, the net estate may not be reduced by the amount of the family allowance or enforceable claims against the estate; and providing for the application of this Act.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – Estates and Trusts

1-101.

(n) “Net estate” means the property of the decedent exclusive of the family allowance and enforceable claims against the estate, except as used in [§ 3-102] §§ 3-102 AND 3-203.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1992 and shall be applicable to persons dying on or after October 1, 1992.

CHAPTER 353

(House Bill 708)

AN ACT concerning

Practice of Medicine – Prosecutions – Limitations

FOR the purpose of increasing to a certain time period the time for bringing a prosecution for an offense of practicing, attempting to practice, or offering to practice medicine without a license; and generally relating to the limitations period on the practice of medicine without a license.
