SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

**Article - Courts and Judicial Proceedings**

5-106.

(P) A PROSECUTION FOR AN OFFENSE UNDER § 14-601 OF THE HEALTH OCCUPATIONS ARTICLE OF PRACTICING, ATTEMPTING TO PRACTICE, OR OFFERING TO PRACTICE MEDICINE WITHOUT A LICENSE SHALL BE INSTITUTED WITHIN 3 YEARS AFTER THE OFFENSE WAS COMMITTED.

**Article - Health Occupations**

14-601.

Except as otherwise provided in this title, a person may not practice, attempt to practice, or offer to practice medicine in this State unless licensed by the Board.

14-607.

(1) A person who violates any provision of this subtitle is guilty of a misdemeanor and on conviction is subject to a fine not exceeding \$5,000 or imprisonment not exceeding 5 years or both.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1992.
