CHAPTER 366

(House Bill 805)

AN ACT concerning

Rubble Landfills – Disposal of Asbestos

FOR the purpose of specifying certain requirements for the disposal of asbestos in a rubble landfill.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – Environment

9-210.

(b) (3) The following types of waste may be disposed of in a rubble landfill subject to the regulations adopted under this subtitle if the disposal of these wastes is expressly approved by the county in its county solid waste management plan:

(i) Asbestos, IF:

1. THE ASBESTOS IS WET OR OTHERWISE IN ACCORDANCE WITH FEDERAL NATIONAL EMISSION STANDARDS FOR HAZARDOUS AIR POLLUTION WHEN DELIVERED TO THE LANDFILL AND LOCATED IN A SEGREGATED AREA OF THE LANDFILL; AND

2. THE OWNER OR OPERATOR OF THE LANDFILL RETAINS A MAP RECORD THAT CLEARLY DELINEATES WHERE THE ASBESTOS HAS BEEN DEPOSITED;
