

(D) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL DEVELOP PROCEDURES TO COORDINATE THE STATEWIDE AVAILABILITY OF TEXTBOOKS AND SUPPLEMENTARY INSTRUCTIONAL MATERIALS IN NONVISUALLY ACCESSIBLE MEDIA.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1992.

CHAPTER 370

(House Bill 881)

AN ACT concerning

Garrett County – Ad Valorem Tax – Landfill Projects

FOR the purpose of authorizing the County Commissioners of Garrett County to impose an ad valorem property tax on certain property to pay for certain landfill-related costs; requiring that the tax be set in a certain manner; requiring that the tax be administered in a certain manner; providing that the tax has the same priority, bears the same rate of interest and penalties, and is subject to the same enforcement procedures as the county property tax; and generally relating to the authorization for and administration of a certain tax in Garrett County.

Section 105-3

Article 12 – Public Local Laws of Maryland

(1985 Edition, as amended)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 12 – Garrett County

105-3.

(A) THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS MAY IMPOSE BY ORDINANCE AN ANNUAL AD VALOREM PROPERTY TAX ON ALL PROPERTY SUBJECT TO THE COUNTY PROPERTY TAX IN ORDER TO PAY ALL OR PART OF:

- (1) THE COSTS OF DEVELOPING A NEW LANDFILL;
- (2) THE COSTS OF CLOSING AN EXISTING LANDFILL; OR
- (3) THE PRINCIPAL OR INTEREST ON ANY BONDS ISSUED BY THE COUNTY FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OR THE CLOSING OF A LANDFILL.
