- (I) THAT ARE CONSISTENT WITH THE STANDARDS ESTABLISHED IN THIS SECTION, FOR THE ISSUANCE OF PERMITS FOR VEHICLE COMBINATIONS DESCRIBED UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION; AND
- (II) THAT EXEMPT FROM THE REQUIREMENTS OF, OR PROVIDE ALTERNATIVE REQUIREMENTS TO, SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS SECTION FOR A VEHICLE MANUFACTURED BEFORE JULY 1, 1991, IF THE VEHICLE CANNOT MEET THE REQUIREMENTS.
- (E) A SPECIAL PERMIT ISSUED UNDER SUBSECTION (D)(1) OF THIS SECTION:
 - (1) MAY BE ISSUED WITHOUT A FEE;
 - (2) MAY BE A RENEWABLE BLANKET PERMIT; AND
- (3) SHALL EXPIRE ON A DATE DETERMINED BY THE SECRETARY.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the provisions of this Act are not severable, and if any provision of this Act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid for any reason in a court of competent jurisdiction, the application of the entire Act shall be invalid.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1992.

CHAPTER 372

(House Bill 911)

AN ACT concerning

Washington Suburban Sanitary District - Bond Issue - Water

PG/MC 17-92

FOR the purpose of authorizing the issuance of bonds for the Washington Suburban Sanitary District in an amount not exceeding \$43,000,000 for enlarging, increasing, and augmenting the water supply and major distribution facilities of the Sanitary District; providing that the bonds shall be guaranteed as to payment of principal and interest by the County Council of Prince George's County and the County Council of Montgomery County, or the governing body for each county, respectively, as may be provided by law or instrument of Charter, with a provision for waiver of the guarantee at the option of the Commission; providing for the payment of the bonds and the interest on the bonds by levy or taxes against assessable property within the Sanitary District; providing for the collection of water service charges;
