the Board to publish certain suspensions and revocations of licenses in the Maryland Register; requiring nursing staff agencies to verify that geriatric nursing assistants comply with certain regulations under certain circumstances; prohibiting nursing staff agencies from knowingly referring certain persons to health care facilities under certain circumstances; requiring nursing staff agencies to report certain actions or conditions to the Board under certain circumstances; providing certain exceptions and immunity; defining certain terms; providing a certain penalty; and generally relating to nursing staff agencies.

(C) THE BOARD SHALL FILE A NOTICE FOR PUBLICATION IN THE EARLIEST PUBLICATION OF THE MARYLAND REGISTER OF EACH REVOCATION OR SUSPENSION OF A LICENSE UNDER THIS SECTION WITHIN 24 HOURS OF THE REVOCATION OR SUSPENSION.

- (A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS INDICATED.
- (2) "HEALTH CARE FACILITY" MEANS A HOSPITAL OR RELATED INSTITUTION AS DEFINED IN § 19–301 OF THE HEALTH GENERAL ARTICLE.
- (3) "INITIALLY PROVIDING OR REFERRING" MEANS THE FIRST TIME A NURSING STAFF AGENCY PROVIDES OR REFERS A PARTICULAR LICENSED PRACTICAL NURSE, REGISTERED NURSE, OR GERIATRIC NURSING ASSISTANT TO A HEALTH CARE FACILITY.

- (I) ANY INDIVIDUAL LICENSED BY THE STATE BOARD OF NURSING AS A:
  - 1. LICENSED PRACTICAL NURSE; OR
  - 2. REGISTERED NURSE; OR
