- (II) THE ACTION OR CONDITION OF THE LICENSED PRACTICAL NURSE OR REGISTERED NURSE HAS NOT CAUSED INJURY TO ANY PERSON WHILE THE LICENSED PRACTICAL NURSE OR REGISTERED NURSE IS PRACTICING LICENSED PRACTICAL NURSING OR REGISTERED NURSING:
- (3) (2) A NURSING STAFF AGENCY IS NOT REQUIRED UNDER THIS SUBSECTION TO MAKE ANY REPORT THAT WOULD BE IN VIOLATION OF ANY FEDERAL OR STATE LAW, RULE, OR REGULATION CONCERNING THE CONFIDENTIALITY OF ALCOHOL AND DRUG ABUSE PATIENT RECORDS.
- (G) (1) SUBJECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF TITLE 10, SUBTITLE 2 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, THE BOARD MAY IMPOSE A PENALTY OF UP TO \$2,000 FOR A VIOLATION OF ANY PROVISION OF THIS SECTION.
- (2) EACH DAY A VIOLATION CONTINUES IS A SEPARATE VIOLATION.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1992.

CHAPTER 374

(House Bill 919)

AN ACT concerning

Motor Vehicle Insurance - Summary of Surcharge Plan

FOR the purpose of requiring every insurer issuing or renewing a policy of private passenger motor vehicle liability insurance in this State to include provide to the policyholder as part of the policy or as part of the billing process a summary of the insurer's approved surcharge plan or driver record point plan for that policy; providing for the form and content of the summary; providing for subsequent copies of the summary only under certain circumstances; providing for the applicability of this Act; and generally relating to the providing as part of the policy or as part of the billing process a summary of the insurer's approved surcharge plan or driver record point plan for that policy at the time of issuance or renewal of a policy of private passenger motor vehicle liability insurance.
