**(House Bill 1073)**

AN ACT concerning

**Prince George's County - Duplicate Alcoholic Beverages License Fee**

**PG 308-92**

FOR the purpose of increasing the fee for a duplicate alcoholic beverages license in Prince George's County.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

Section 73

Annotated Code of Maryland

(1990 Replacement Volume and 1991 Supplement)

SECTION 1: BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

**Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages**

73.

(A) [Whenever] EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION, WHENEVER any license issued under the provisions of this article has been lost, or destroyed, the official issuing such a license shall have the power, upon application under oath, and upon payment of a fee of [one dollar (\$1.00)] \$1, to issue another license, upon which shall be endorsed the word "duplicate" in addition to all of the information which appeared upon the original license.
