- (1) PROVIDE THE MATERIALS DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION TO THE PUBLIC; AND
- (2) ASSIST AND ADVISE AN INDIVIDUAL WHO REQUESTS ASSISTANCE OR ADVICE IN THE PREPARATION OF ANY FORMS DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION.
- (C) A CLAIM RESULTING FROM AN ACT OR OMISSION OF A CLERK OF A COURT OR A DESIGNATED EMPLOYEE ARISING OUT OF ASSISTANCE OR ADVICE PROVIDED UNDER SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION SHALL BE SUBJECT TO THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT TORT CLAIMS ACT.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1992.

FOR the purpose of increasing the fee for a duplicate alcoholic beverages license in Prince George's County.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

73.

(A) [Whenever] EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION, WHENEVER any license issued under the provisions of this article has been lost, or destroyed, the official issuing such a license shall have the power, upon application under oath, and upon payment of a fee of [one dollar (\$1.00)] \$1, to issue another license, upon which shall be endorsed the word "duplicate" in addition to all of the information which appeared upon the original license.
