- (3) The Governor shall appoint one licensed social worker member from a list of qualified individuals submitted to the Governor by the Maryland Chapter of the National Association of Social Workers, Inc.
- (4) The Governor shall appoint one licensed social worker member from a list of qualified individuals submitted to the Governor by the Metropolitan Washington Chapter of the National Association of Social Workers, Inc.
- (5) The Governor shall appoint the other two licensed social worker members.
- (6) The Governor shall appoint the consumer member with the advice of the Secretary and the advice and consent of the Senate.

In addition to the powers and duties set forth elsewhere in this title, the Board has the following powers and duties:

- (1) To adopt rules and regulations to carry out the provisions of this title, INCLUDING REGULATIONS TO CREATE OTHER SPECIALTY LICENSES AS NECESSARY AND APPROPRIATE:
 - (2) To adopt a code of ethics;
 - (3) To adopt an official seal;
- (4) To hold hearings and keep records and minutes necessary for the orderly conduct of business; and
- (5) To issue a list annually of all currently licensed social workers. 19–302.
- (a) To qualify for a license, an applicant shall be an individual OF GOOD MORAL CHARACTER AND who meets the applicable requirements of this section.
 - (d) (1) An applicant for a certified social worker license shall have:
- [(1)] (i) A master's degree from an accredited college or university and based on a graduate social work program accredited by the Council on Social Work Education; and
- (ii) 2 years of social work experience AS A SOCIAL WORKER WHERE FACE-TO-FACE SUPERVISION IS PART OF THE EMPLOYMENT CONTRACT AND THE SUPERVISOR IS A LICENSED CERTIFIED SOCIAL WORKER AND IS PROVIDED BY AND ACCOUNTABLE TO THE EMPLOYER after receiving the master's degree [and under the supervision of a licensed certified social worker; or
- (2) (i) A doctorate in social work from an accredited college or university; and
