## **CHAPTER 389**

(House Bill 1088)

## AN ACT concerning

## Solid Waste Management - Composting

FOR the purpose of promoting composting as a viable method of managing solid waste in the State; requiring the Secretary of Agriculture to adopt as regulations certain product standards for compost; requiring certain units of State and local government to give certain consideration and preference to the use of compost for certain purposes; requiring reprocessing or disposal of compost which does not meet certain standards under certain circumstances excluding compost from the definition of solid waste; requiring counties to address certain forms of composting in certain recycling plans; requiring allowing certain yard waste to be transported to a composting facility under certain circumstances; prohibiting an owner or operator of a refuse disposal system from accepting certain yard waste unless the waste is to be composted or mulched under certain circumstances; requiring the Department of the Environment to prepare a certain report by a certain date; requiring certain units of State government to review certain specifications and practices, and to incorporate certain practices; providing certain exceptions; defining certain terms; providing for the application of this Act; providing for a delayed effective date for portions of this Act; and generally relating to the regulation of certain composting processes.
