- (j) (1) "Solid waste stream" means garbage or refuse that would, unless recycled, be disposed of in a refuse disposal system located in this State.
 - (2) "Solid waste stream" does not include:
 - (i) Hospital waste;
 - (ii) Rubble;
 - (iii) Scrap material;
 - (iv) Land clearing debris;
 - (v) Sewage sludge; or
- (vi) Waste generated by a single individual or business and disposed of in a facility dedicated solely for that entity's waste.
 - (k) "White goods" includes:
 - (1) Refrigerators;
 - (2) Stoves;
 - (3) Washing machines;
 - (4) Dryers;
 - (5) Water heaters; and
 - (6) Air conditioners.
- (L) "COMPOST" MEANS THE PRODUCT OF COMPOSTING IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE STANDARDS ESTABLISHED BY THE SECRETARY UNDER PART III OF THIS SUBTITLE OF AGRICULTURE UNDER § 6-221 OF THE AGRICULTURE ARTICLE.
- (M) "COMPOSTING" MEANS THE CONTROLLED BIOLOGICAL DECOMPOSITION OF ORGANIC WASTE MATERIAL IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE STANDARDS ESTABLISHED BY THE SECRETARY UNDER PART III-OF THIS SUBTITLE TITLE.
- (N) "GENERATOR OF COMPOST" MEANS A PERSON WHO PRODUCES COMPOST FOR SALE TO A CONSUMER.
- (O) (N) (1) "YARD WASTE" MEANS ORGANIC PLANT WASTE DERIVED FROM GARDENING, LANDSCAPING, AND TREE TRIMMING ACTIVITIES.
- (2) "YARD WASTE" INCLUDES LEAVES, GARDEN WASTE, LAWN CUTTINGS, WEEDS, AND PRUNINGS.
