SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

- (d) (1) The hours during which the privileges conferred by a Class D beer license may be exercised shall be from 6 o'clock a.m. to 12 o'clock midnight.
- (5) (I) In Prince George's County the hours shall be from 6 o'clock a.m. to 2-o'clock a.m. on the day following.
- (II) THE PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY BOARD OF LICENSE COMMISSIONERS MAY UNIFORMLY CHANGE THE CLOSING HOUR AND REDUCE THE HOURS OF SALES UNDER ALL CLASS D BEER LICENSES THAT ARE ISSUED WITHIN THE CORPORATE BOUNDARIES OF A MUNICIPAL CORPORATION IN PRINCE GEORGE'S. IF THE BOARD:
- 1. RECEIVES A RESOLUTION OR ORDINANCE ENACTED BY THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION THAT REQUESTS A UNIFORM REDUCTION IN HOURS OF SALE UNDER THIS LICENSE; AND
- 2. AFTER A HEARING, DETERMINES THAT THE CLOSING TIME SHOULD BE CHANGED.

- (d) (1) The hours during which the privileges conferred by a Class D beer and light wine license may be exercised shall be from 6 o'clock a.m. to 12 o'clock midnight.
- (4) (I) In Prince George's County the hours shall be from 6 o'clock a.m. to 2 o'clock a.m. on the day following.
- (II) THE PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY BOARD OF LICENSE COMMISSIONERS MAY UNIFORMLY CHANGE THE CLOSING HOUR AND REDUCE THE HOURS OF SALES UNDER ALL CLASS D BEER AND LIGHT WINE LICENSES THAT ARE ISSUED WITHIN THE CORPORATE BOUNDARIES OF A MUNICIPAL CORPORATION IN PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY, IF THE BOARD:
