- 1. RECEIVES A RESOLUTION OR ORDINANCE ENACTED BY THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION THAT REQUESTS A UNIFORM REDUCTION IN HOURS OF SALE UNDER THIS LICENSE; AND
- 2. AFTER A HEARING, DETERMINES THAT THE CLOSING TIME SHOULD BE CHANGED.

- (H) (1) IN THE 24TH LEGISLATIVE DISTRICT OF PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY, NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF THIS ARTICLE, THE BOARD OF LICENSE COMMISSIONERS MAY CHANGE THE CLOSING HOUR AND REDUCE THE HOURS OF SALE OF ANY LICENSEE, UNDER ANY CLASS OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES LICENSE, IN THE COUNTY:
- (I) ON RECEIPT OF A BONA FIDE COMPLAINT CONCERNING THE LICENSED PREMISES; AND
  - (II) AFTER A HEARING ON THE COMPLAINT.
- (2) A DECISION OF THE BOARD OF LICENSE COMMISSIONERS MADE UNDER THIS SUBSECTION MAY BE APPEALED AS PROVIDED UNDER § 175 OF THIS ARTICLE.
