

Article 2B – Alcoholic Beverages

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 2B – Alcoholic Beverages

25.

(c) (1) (i) Special beer, wine and liquor license, Class C, which entitles the holder to exercise any of the privileges conferred by this class of license for the use of any person holding a bona fide entertainment conducted by a club, society, or association at the place described for a period not exceeding seven consecutive days, upon the payment of a fee of \$15 per day.

(2) In Prince George’s County:

(I) [the] EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBPARAGRAPH (II) OF THIS PARAGRAPH, THE fee is [~~\$30~~] \$50 per day[.];

(II) FOR A CLUB, SOCIETY, OR ASSOCIATION HOLDING A CASINO OR GAMBLING EVENT, THE FEE IS ~~\$100~~ \$150 PER DAY; AND

(III) The Board of License Commissioners may deny an application for this license if it is determined that the applicant does not qualify under the provisions of this article.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1992.

Prince George’s County – Alcoholic Beverages License Fees

PG 310-92

FOR the purpose of increasing the daily fee for certain special Class C alcoholic beverages licenses; and creating a higher daily fee for these licenses when used during certain events.

BY repealing and reenacting, without amendments,
