

(i) 8 shall be members of the Senate appointed by the President of the Senate; and

(ii) 8 shall be members of the House of Delegates appointed by the Speaker of the House.

(c) The members of the Committee serve at the pleasure of the presiding officer who appointed them.

(d) The President and the Speaker shall jointly appoint a Senator and a Delegate each to serve as cochairman.

(e) The Department of Fiscal Services shall provide staff assistance to the Committee.

(f) The Committee shall work with the Executive Branch on the Medical Assistance Program and make recommendations to the General Assembly.

(g) This section shall terminate on June 30, 1992.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1992.

CHAPTER 396

(House Bill 1149)

AN ACT concerning

Carroll County – Abatement of Nuisances – Enforcement

FOR the purpose of authorizing Carroll County to take certain action following a nuisance complaint due to weed growth, under certain circumstances; exempting land enrolled in certain State or federal programs from a certain determination concerning weed growth; repealing inappropriate references to a local health officer; and providing that certain responsibility rests with the State or federal agency that administers the program.
