

B. THE COUNTY COUNCIL MAY IMPOSE A TRANSFER TAX ON AN INSTRUMENT OF WRITING:

(1) RECORDED WITH THE CLERK OF THE CIRCUIT COURT FOR WICOMICO COUNTY; OR

(2) FILED WITH THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF ASSESSMENTS AND TAXATION.

C. A TRANSFER TAX UNDER THIS SECTION:

(1) SHALL BE ESTABLISHED BY ORDINANCE;

(2) MAY NOT EXCEED 1%; AND

(3) DOES NOT APPLY TO:

(A) AN INSTRUMENT OF WRITING EXEMPT FROM THE STATE TRANSFER TAX UNDER § 13-207 OF THE TAX - PROPERTY ARTICLE OF THE ANNOTATED CODE OF MARYLAND; OR

(B) A TRANSFER OF LAND SUBJECT TO THE AGRICULTURAL LAND TRANSFER TAX UNDER TITLE 13, SUBTITLE 3 OF THE TAX - PROPERTY ARTICLE OF THE ANNOTATED CODE OF MARYLAND.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1992.

CHAPTER 400

(House Bill 1214)

AN ACT concerning

Vehicle Laws - Traffic Citations - Compliance with Notice to Appear

FOR the purpose of authorizing a person who intends to comply in a certain manner with a notice to appear contained in a traffic citation to request, under certain circumstances, a hearing on sentencing and disposition in lieu of a trial; providing that a person who requests a hearing regarding sentencing and disposition under this Act waives certain rights; requiring a traffic citation to contain a certain notice; and generally relating to methods for complying with the notice to appear contained in a traffic citation.
