- (iii) Direction, destination, or termini signs on any passenger common carrier motor vehicle.
- (d) (1) Except as provided in paragraph (2) of this subsection, a person may not drive a vehicle with any sign, poster, card, sticker, or other nontransparent material on the windshield, side wings, or side or rear windows of the vehicle.
 - (2) This subsection does not apply to:
- (i) Materials placed on the windshield OR REAR WINDOW, within a 7 inch square area in the lower corner, or on the side windows of the vehicle to the rear of the driver, if the materials are placed so as not to interfere with the <u>driver's</u> clear view of the driver of approaching traffic; or
- (ii) Direction, destination, or termini signs on any passenger common carrier motor vehicle.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1992.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
