SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 27 - Crimes and Punishments

754B.

- (a) Subject to the provisions of §§ 742 through 755 of this article, the Public Service Commission or a county or municipal corporation may request a criminal background record check on an applicant for a taxicab driver's license from the Criminal Justice Information System Central Repository of the Department of Public Safety and Correctional Services.
- (b) On any request for a criminal background record check made by the Public Service Commission under Article 78, § 50H of the Code or by a county or municipal corporation, the applicant for a taxicab driver's license shall pay to the Department any required processing fee and administrative cost.
- (c) When a request is made to the Central Repository under subsection (a) of this section, the Central Repository shall conduct its record check and issue a report to the Public Service Commission or the county or municipal corporation within 25 calendar days of the request.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1991. It shall remain effective for a period of [one year] 3 YEARS and, at the end of [June 30, 1992,] SEPTEMBER 30, 1995 with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1992.
