- (A) (1) THE COMMISSION SHALL MEET AT LEAST QUARTERLY AND AT THE TIMES AND PLACES IT DETERMINES.
- (2) THE SECRETARY OF THE DEPARTMENT SHALL PROVIDE SUCH MEETING AND HEARING ROOMS AS THE COMMISSION MAY REQUIRE.
- (B) AT ITS FIRST MEETING OF EACH CALENDAR YEAR, FROM AMONG ITS MEMBERS, THE COMMISSION SHALL ELECT A CHAIRMAN, VICE CHAIRMAN, AND SECRETARY.
- (B) THE GOVERNOR SHALL APPOINT THE CHAIRMAN OF THE COMMISSION.
- (C) ANY MEMBER OF THE COMMISSION WHO IS ABSENT FROM 3 OR MORE CONSECUTIVE MEETINGS SHALL BE CONSIDERED AS HAVING VACATED THE OFFICE AND THE GOVERNOR SHALL PROMPTLY SELECT ANOTHER PERSON TO FILL THAT VACANCY WHO REPRESENTS THE SAME INTERESTS AS THE PERSON DETERMINED TO HAVE VACATED THE OFFICE.
- (C) ATTENDANCE AT COMMISSION MEETINGS, RESIGNATION FOR FAILURE TO ATTEND MEETINGS, AND APPOINTMENTS TO FILL VACANCIES FOR FAILURE TO ATTEND MEETINGS SHALL BE GOVERNED BY ARTICLE 41, § 1–203 OF THE CODE.
  - (D) A MEMBER OF THE COMMISSION:
    - (1) MAY NOT RECEIVE COMPENSATION: BUT
- (2) IS ENTITLED TO REIMBURSEMENT FROM THE <u>PREVENTION</u> FUND FOR REASONABLE TRAVEL EXPENSES RELATED TO ATTENDING MEETINGS; WORKSHOPS, CONFERENCES; AND OTHER COMMISSION EVENTS IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE STANDARD STATE TRAVEL REGULATIONS.

6-806.

- (A) (1) THE COMMISSION SHALL APPOINT AN EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR AND ANY OTHER PERSONS NECESSARY TO CARRY OUT THE DUTIES AND FUNCTIONS OF THE COMMISSION.
  - (2) THE COMMISSION SHALL:
- (I) PRESCRIBE THE DUTIES OF THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR AND STAFF: AND
- (II) FIX COMPENSATION AND PROVIDE REIMBURSEMENT OF THEIR EXPENSES IN ACCORDANCE WITH MONEYS AVAILABLE IN THE FUND.
