- (A) THERE IS A LEAD PAINT POISONING PREVENTION AND COMPENSATION FUND.
- (B) THE <u>PREVENTION</u> FUND SHALL BE UNDER THE DIRECTION OF THE COMMISSION AND SHALL BE ADMINISTERED BY THE STAFF OF THE COMMISSION <u>AS PROVIDED IN THE ANNUAL BUDGET OF THE STATE OR BY SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION</u>.

- (2) THE CERTIFICATION FEES TRANSFERRED FROM THE ESCROW ACCOUNT INTO THE FUND UNDER § 6-808(F) OF THIS SUBTITLE; AND
- (3) (2) ANY OTHER MONEYS RECEIVED UNDER § 6 809 OF THIS SUBTITLE BY GRANT, DONATION, OR APPROPRIATION.
  - (D) THE PREVENTION FUND SHALL BE USED TO PAY:
- (1) ANY AWARD GRANTED UNDER §§ 6-811 AND 6-812 OF THIS SUBTITLE:
- (2) EXPENSES RELATED TO REMEDIAL REHABILITATION FOR CLAIMANTS WHO HAVE RECEIVED AWARDS UNDER THIS SUBTITLE; AND
- (1) DIRECT EXPENSES OF THE DEPARTMENT AND THE COMMISSION WITH RESPECT TO THEIR OBLIGATIONS AND RESPONSIBILITIES UNDER THIS SUBTITLE;
- (2) <u>DIRECT EXPENSES OF ANY OTHER STATE UNIT IN</u>
  <u>CARRYING OUT ITS OBLIGATIONS AND RESPONSIBILITIES UNDER THIS</u>
  <u>SUBTITLE; AND</u>
- (3) ANY OTHER EXPENSE AUTHORIZED BY THE COMMISSION RELATED TO THE ADMINISTRATION OF THE <u>PREVENTION</u> FUND; INCLUDING EXPENSES INCURRED BY OTHER STATE AGENCIES IN CARRYING OUT THEIR DUTIES DESCRIBED IN THIS SUBTITLE.
