AN ACT concerning

Pensions and Retirement - Technical Corrections

FOR the purpose of clarifying that certain employees of Dorchester County may continue to be members of the Employees' Retirement System of the State of Maryland or participate in the Pension System for Employees of the State of Maryland; clarifying the authority under which certain deductions or reductions in salary may be made for participants in a certain optional retirement program; and generally relating to technical corrections to the State law on State pension and retirement systems.
