CHAPTER 418

(House Bill 1453)

AN ACT concerning

Committed Individuals – Hospital Warrants – Issuance

FOR the purpose of altering certain provisions of law to ~~permit~~ require a court to issue a hospital warrant for a committed individual under certain circumstances; requiring a court to notify the central repository of the criminal justice information system when it issues a hospital warrant; defining a certain term; and generally relating to the issuance of hospital warrants under certain circumstances.
