

**CHAPTER 421**

**(House Bill 1466)**

AN ACT concerning

**Horse Racing – Great Pocomoke Fair**

FOR the purpose of exempting certain horse racing held by the Great Pocomoke Fair, Inc. from the laws governing horse racing in the State; making a section of this Act contingent on the taking effect of another Act; making this Act an emergency measure; and generally relating to horse racing in the State.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

**Article 78B – Racing Commission**

(c) (1) Except as provided in paragraph (2) of this subsection, the jurisdiction, supervision, powers and duties of the Maryland Racing Commission shall extend to any and all person or persons, associations or corporations that holds or conducts any meeting within the State of Maryland where horse racing shall be permitted for any stake, purse or reward.

(2) Paragraph (1) of this subsection may not be construed to apply to the following races unless parimutuel betting is conducted:

(i) The Maryland Hunt Cup;

(ii) The Grand National;

(iii) Races held at the Cape Pine Farm in Church Hill, Queen Anne's

County;

(iv) The Potomac Trials;
